

**Announcement for Foreign Students Application for Master Program (with Thesis)
2020-2021 Academic Year**

Institute of Rumi Studies will accept Foreign students to the Master's Program with Thesis in the 2020/2021 Academic Year.

Candidate students should send the requested documents in PDF format for pre-application to mevlana@selcuk.edu.tr by 05.09.2020, 23.59. The applications after the deadline will not be accepted. Applications will be assessed by a commission at the Institute of Rumi Studies. The results will be published on the website of the Selçuk University Institute of Rumi Studies on 17.09.2020.

The students admitted to the Master's Program should bring their documents individually or via power of attorney to the Institute by 25.09.2020.

The reserve list will not be announced.

Application Requirements for Foreign Candidates

1. Applications will be made individually or by power of attorney. According to the article 10/1 of the Selcuk University Graduate Education Regulation, the applications after September will be accepted for the spring semester; the applications after February will be accepted for the fall semester.
2. The tuition fee for the Master's Program with Thesis is 2.580 TL. The tuition fee can be paid in two installments as 1.290 TL during the fall semester and spring semester.
3. Students who do not have a TÖMER certificate but study at TÖMER for the certificate will not pay the tuition fee within this period.
4. Students who will take Scientific Preparation Courses will pay a tuition fee of 1.290 TL per semester during the lecture period.
5. Turkish citizens with dual nationality will not be able to apply as foreign students.
6. Students enrolled in any higher education institution will not be able to apply.
7. The admitted students who do not bring the requested documents within the given time will lose their enrollment rights.

The Requested Documents for Application

1. Foreign Student Application Document (www.mevlana.selcuk.edu.tr)
2. Original and photocopy of the undergraduate diploma and transcript and translations approved by the notary or consulate
3. Original and photocopy of passport
4. Two headshots
5. Original and photocopy of residence permit or original and photocopy residence permit for educational purposes
6. Certificate of Recognition from the Higher Education Council for the institutions students graduated from
7. Original and photocopy of TÖMER certificate and Turkish proficiency certificate issued from Yunus Emre Institute Cultural Centers (For those who do not have a TÖMER certificate, Article 10/2 of the Selçuk University Graduate Education Regulation will be applied)
8. Original Reference Letter, Turkish translation, and its photocopy
9. Bank receipt showing that the tuition fee has been paid to the Vakıfbank student number (will not be sent in the pre-application.)
