WELL-ESTABLISHED UNIVERSITY, WELL-ESTABLISHED FACULTY

Founded in 1975, our university is one of the most well-established universities in Türkiye. Officially established within Selçuk University in 1982, the foundations of our Faculty of Law date back to the Konya School of Law in 1908. By its establishment, it is among the oldest, top 5 law faculties in Türkiye.

QUALIFIED AND STRONG ACADEMIC STAFF

We have 10 Professors, 8 Associate Professors, 16 Assistant Professors, and 25 Research Assistants. Our faculty ranks at the forefront among all law faculties in our country in terms of the breadth of our academic staff spectrum.

It is obvious how important the richness of an academic staff with international experience is for our students to acquire legal knowledge and achieve success in life.

COMPREHENSIVE CAMPUS AND FACULTY FACILITIES

Our university has one of the largest campuses by land area in Türkiye and houses many social, cultural, sports, and educational facilities.

Leading these are social, cultural, and sports facilities such as a stadium, two indoor sports halls, tennis courts, a full Olympic swimming pool, equestrian facilities, performance and representation halls, and a university radio and television station; as well as educational areas like our central library and faculty library, congress, conference, and symposium halls, and our technopolis.

Our faculty is located within one of the largest campuses in our country. Our campus also features five state dormitories (KYK), two main dining halls, tram and ring shuttle services, and a fifty-seven percent green space ratio. Our students actively participate in all activities held on our campus. Furthermore, there is free campus-wide Wi-Fi and direct off-campus access to library databases via VETİS.

Comprehensive library:

In addition to our university's central library, we have a comprehensive law library within our building containing 15,470 printed works, over 10,000 e-books, and 100 different periodicals.

We have two reading rooms with a total capacity of 240 people. We will increase these numbers further within the year. Our library offers rich resources to both our academics and students through online databases such as Heinonline, Hukuktürk, Jurix, Kazancı, Lexpera, SobiAD, BookCites, and Turcademy.

CULTIVATING LEGAL MINDS BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

In addition to legal education at our faculty, seminars, talks, and national and international symposia are organized with the active contribution of 9 student communities. High-level importance and support are given by both our Rectorate and Dean's Office to such professional and cultural activities, especially those involving student participation.

Efforts are made to ensure our students acquire a legal mindset that is not limited to coursework; aiming to prepare them in the best possible way for all areas of life. As a result of these opportunities, our students have published articles in peer-reviewed law journals and received awards. Additionally, our students have prepared lots of TÜBİTAK 2209-A projects and hold national rankings such as 3rd and 8th place in competitions like the Mekteb-i Adliye and ISTAC Moot Court.

POST-GRADUATION SUCCESS

Among the 16,031 graduates of our faculty to date, there are numerous members of the high judiciary, public prosecutors, judges, attorneys, and notaries. Having produced the first-place winner and numerous high-ranking candidates in the Judicial and Administrative Judiciary Judge Candidate Exam, our faculty always ranks at the very top among all law faculties with its high success rate in career exams.
