Size Birleşik Krallık Hükümeti Dışişleri, Milletler Topluluğu ve Kalkınma Bakanlığı tarafından finanse edilen, uluslararası saygınlığa sahip Chevening yüksek lisans burs programı hakkında bilgilendirmek için yazıyorum.

- T.C. vatandaşı olmak ve eğitimi tamamladıktan sonra Türkiye dönerek en az iki yıl kalmak,
- Başvuru sırasında iki yıl iş tecrübesi şartını tamamlamış olmak,
- Birleşik Krallık'ta bir yüksek lisans programına kabul edilmek için gereken lisans derecesine ve diplomasına sahip olmak,
- Birleşik Krallık üniversitelerinde en az üç farklı programa - dil yeterliliği de dahil istenen tüm şartları yerine getirecek şekilde - başvurarak 11 Temmuz 2024 tarihine kadar en az bir tanesine şartsız olarak kabul edilmek.

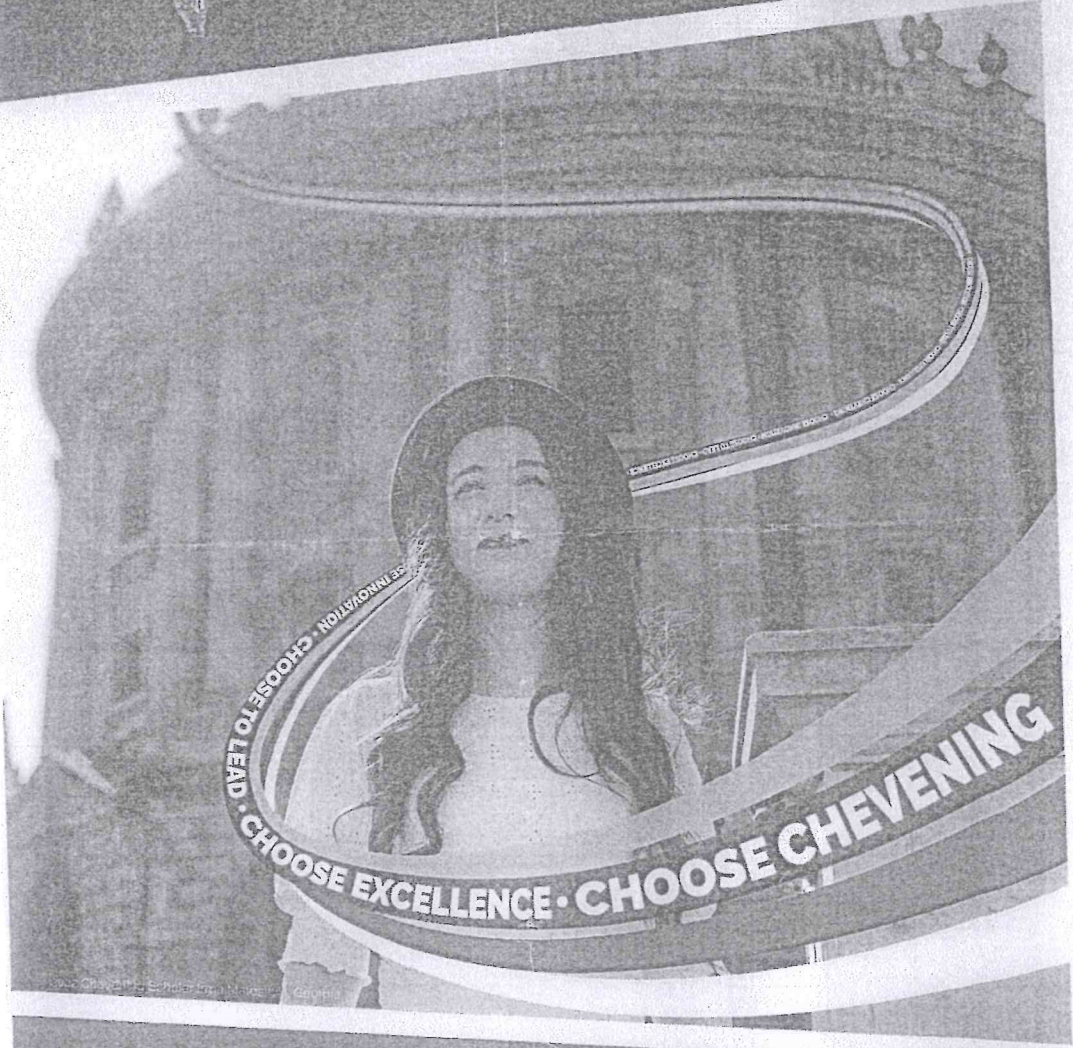

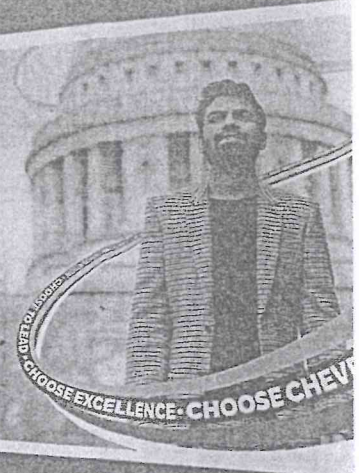
